### QUOTES:

#### **Matt Knoll, Baylor Head Coach**

"We couldn't have had a better guy out there, a senior who has been in that spot a bunch. We felt confident. It was a heck of a match. I thought their guy really picked it up at the end of the second set. In the third he served better than he had in the rest of the match. We were able to squeeze out that late break. Then we just made a couple uncharacteristic errors late in the breaker and that's that."

"It doesn't come down to Julian (Bley). We had a lot of other guys that had opportunities. It is amplified because he is the last guy out there. I am proud of his effort. He worked his tail off. Everybody could see the guys were really getting after it. I am proud of both guys. I think their guy did a great job."

"It was a tough match with two good teams. They beat us 4-3 at their place and now 4-3 again today. This match was way more competitive coming down to the last match on. We think we are getting better. We made some good steps in this tournament and I think if we can improve two or three percent going into the NCAAs we are going to have a chance to do some good things out there."

#### **John Roddick, Oklahoma Head Coach**

"That was a great college tennis match. That is what people come to watch. Coaches don't come to watch those. Baylor played great doubles. That is probably a point they weren't expecting to win necessarily. We have been expecting to win it all year, so for us to fight back and find four singles wins out there was a heck of an effort. To win it like that at the end with a player who has been on the bench for us for a couple of matches, it is incredibly special for him."

(On Dane Webb) "Dane has been a great player for us all year. Had he lost that tiebreaker, you always like to win the first set, but I was still very comfortable with having him out there. Winning the first makes it easier, but Dane believes in himself that he is going to win. I think he has actually forgotten how to lose at times. He has done a great job and he has achieved every goal he set out for himself this year so far."

(On winning the title) "This is a big goal. This is still a little new for this team, so we will have to do a very good job in the coming weeks re-focusing our efforts and readjusting what we want to do as a team. I think we will be able to do it. Luckily, we had a good run in the NCAAs two years ago, so we have an understanding of what it takes. We will give them a couple days, but they will have to forget about this pretty soon."
