#### Patty Fendick-McCain, Texas Head Coach

"We played much better today. We had an unfortunate go against them last weekend. The conditions were very similar today as they were last weekend. We worked pretty hard this week. It was a big mental hurdle for us to get over today. We didn't play very well last weekend, but we played much better today. It was great to see the girls get a win."

On playing Texas Tech tomorrow:

#### Chris Young, Oklahoma State Head Coach
