#### Joey Scrivano, Baylor Head Coach

"They have a good team, a really good team. We were fortunate to come through. We just battled. That is the thing that I am most pleased about. The conditions were obviously really tough and we just kept competing on all of the courts. That is all you can ask for."

On the doubles point...

"It is just another point. The name of the game is you have to get to four points. Today it did come in handy because we were struggling in singles. That had a lot to do with Oklahoma."

"The biggest thing today that helped us is that we turned two matchups that we lost in the regular season. For us to have the success in the postseason that we want to have, our freshmen developing is a big key. We were noticing the last month that the freshmen were playing better, and I think today was a big breakthrough for us. If we can get our whole team to compete hard from start to finish, then I think we are a pretty darn tough team to play."

On tomorrow...

"We are going to rest, but we are going to prepare. A lot goes into it, so we are going to be spending every second we have trying to prepare to play A&M. They are a darn tough team, so we are going to have to be prepared."

#### David Mullins, Oklahoma Head Coach

"Our girls battled hard. That is all we can ask of them. We won the doubles against them last time. We definitely needed to win the doubles again today to give ourselves a chance. They didn't put their heads down and they fought all of the way through. It could have been easy to do after that doubles point. We gave ourselves a great chance, especially at No. 1, 2 and 3. Baylor never loses at those spots and we gave ourselves a chance at those spots, so I am proud of the girls."
