



Game Notes: No. 7 Oklahoma State 79, No. 10 KU 75

Big 12 Championship Notes

- This was the sixth meeting between Oklahoma State and Kansas at the Big 12 Championship. The Cowgirls have won the last three straight games at the tournament against the Jayhawks, tying up the series 3-3.
- Tonight's match-up was the fourth time these two teams have met in the first round. The last was in 2010 when the No. 7-seed Cowgirls beat the No. 10-seed Jayhawks, 76-69.
- This was the first appearance for the Cowgirls in the first round since 2012. With the win, OSU improved to 1-2 in the opening round of the tournament.
- OSU has won three of its last four second-round games, and will face Texas for only the second time at the Big 12 Championship. OSU and UT met in the semi-final game in 2008, where No. 3-seed OSU won 75-72.
- Coach Jim Littell improves to 4-5 at the Big 12 Championship, and it is the first time that his team as the No. 7-seed has advanced to the second round.

Individual & Team Notes

- OSU juniors Kaylee Jensen and Mandy Coleman both recorded double-doubles in the first-round matchup against KU, which was also the fourth time this season that both reached the mark in the same game. Jensen knotted her 17th double-digit performance this season with 23 points and 12 rebounds. Coleman had her sixth double-double, the second straight against the Jayhawks, tabbing 14 points and 18 rebounds.
- Mandy Coleman became only the seventh player to grab 18 rebounds in a single game in Big 12 Championship history. She ranks fourth all-time in most rebounds in a first-round game.
- Kansas junior Jessica Washington led her team with 18 points and scored in double figures for the 23rd time this season, her 39th career double-digit scoring performance.
- KU's Washington shot 10-for-10 from the free throw line, moving her into the second spot on the Big 12 Championship records for highest free throw percentage.
