Big 12 Championship Notes

- Texas improved to 6-1 in the first round of the Big 12 Championship and 25-20 overall. The Longhorns are now 4-1 against Texas Tech in the Championship and 3-1 as the No. 10 seed. Texas Tech's first-round record moved to 8-11 and 13-21 overall. The Red Raiders are now 2-3 as the No. 7 seed.
- Tonight's Session I attendance was 18,972. This marks the 18th consecutive sold-out session of the Phillips 66 Men's Basketball Championship at Sprint Center.
- The Longhorns advance to play No. 2 seed West Virginia in Thursday's quarterfinals. The Mountaineers swept the regular season match-ups, winning 74-72 in Austin and 77-62 in Morgantown.

Individual & Team Notes

- Three Texas Tech players finished in double figures. Junior guard Keenan Evans scored a team-high 11 points, senior forward Anthony Livingston tallied 10 points and senior forward Matthew Temple scored 10 points to reach double digits for the third time this season.
- Freshman Andrew Jones led the Longhorns in scoring for the second time this season with 15 points.
- UT snapped a seven-game losing streak. It's last victory was against Iowa State on February 7 (67-65) in Austin.
- After trailing by 12, Texas out scored TTU 50-29 over the last 24:32 of the contest. The Longhorns took their first lead of the game on a Kerwin Roach Jr. free throw at the 5:30 mark.
- This was Texas' third time overcoming a 12-point deficit this season. They previously came back to win against Alabama (77-68) and Long Beach State (71-65).
- The 20-point first half total was also the lowest for Texas this season.
