Game Notes: No. 2 Texas 71, No. 7 Oklahoma State 60

Big 12 Championship Notes

- Texas and Oklahoma State met for only the second time in Big 12 Championship play. With the win, the Longhorns evened the series 1-1, with the Cowgirls winning, 75-72, in a 2008 semifinal game.
- Texas is 5-3 all-time as a No. 2 seed in the Big 12 Championship, including a 4-0 mark in second round games as a No. 2. UT is now 10-7 in second-round action.
- Texas advances to the semifinals for the fourth-straight time under Coach Karen Aston, the 10th time in program history. The Longhorns are 5-2 in their last seven Big 12 Championship games since 2015, with both losses to Baylor in the finals.
- For the past seven years, the No. 2 seed has advanced to the semifinals. The No. 2 seed is now 19-2 in the second round all time in Big 12 Championship play.
- The No. 7 seed is now 2-13 in second-round games, with Oklahoma State being the last No. 7 seed to win in the second round in 2010.

Individual & Team Notes

- Texas had four players in double figures, with Big 12 Player of the Year Brooke McCarty leading with 13 points, her 25th time in 30 games to reach double-figure scoring this season.
- Texas sophomore Jordan Hosey had a season-high 10 points in just 11 minutes on the floor.
- The Longhorns 48 points by the bench ties for the most against a Big 12 opponent this season (West Virginia, 48, Jan. 14, 2017).
- Oklahoma State junior Kaylee Jensen led all scorers with 18 points, which was the 30th time in 31 games this season she has reached double-digit scoring.
- OSU's Latashia Jones had 11 points, a season-high and tournament-best for the sophomore.
