CONFERENCE NOTES

- The 2017 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship game features No. 6 Texas and No. 8 Oklahoma State. Texas heads into the Championship with a 3-1 record while Oklahoma State has a perfect 3-0 record in Oklahoma City this week.
Division one of the bracket includes: No. 1 Texas Tech, No. 4 West Virginia, No. 5 Baylor and No. 8 Oklahoma State. Division two includes: No. 2 TCU, No. 3 Oklahoma, No. 6 Texas and No. 7 Kansas.
Although TCU and Texas Tech had a similar 16-8 mark in league play, TTU's series win over the Horned Frogs earned them the top seed in this week's Championship.
For the third time overall and first time since 2011, Big 12 baseball has regular season co-champions. TCU clinched a share with a win over Oklahoma in Norman on May 12 while Texas Tech earned a share after a sweep of Kansas last weekend.
Oklahoma State, Texas and Texas Tech head into championship week having won their last conference series, one of which was played at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark.
Prior to the pre-championship luncheon, the All-Big 12 Teams and individual award winners were announced based on their success in the regular season. Full lists are on pg. 2.
Through Sunday's games, this is the fourth-straight week that all league teams have a .500 or better overall record.
The 2017 Academic All-Big 12 Baseball Team honors 89 student-athletes, including Matt Wilson (OSU) and Ryan Long (TTU) with perfect 4.0 GPAs. The team is comprised of 54 first team members and 25 second team honorees.
Through Sunday's games, the league has 67 percent of its teams in the RPI top 25, the most among all conferences. The RPI is as follows:

Texas Tech's Grant Little recorded Big 12 Player of the Week honors while TTU's Ryan Shetter was named Pitcher of the Week and Shea Langeliers of Baylor earned Newcomer of the Week.
The league holds a 40-26 (.606) record over Power 5 Conference teams, having 15 wins over Pac-12 opponents and 11 wins against the SEC.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

ALL-CONFERENCE NOTES

TCU's Evan Skoug, the Co-Big 12 Player of the Year, leads the Big 12 with 16 home runs and ranks third in the league with 54 RBIs. His .370 average in conference play ranks fourth in the league, while his 10 home runs and 28 RBIs led all hitters to help the Horned Frogs win a share of the league title.

The Co-Player of the Year, Texas Tech's Hunter Hargrove, leads the league in doubles this season (22) and is hitting .347 on the year, good for top five in the Big 12. He currently ranks second in hits with 75 to help Texas Tech capture its second-straight conference title.

The league's Pitcher of the Year, Texas Tech's Steven Gingery, leads the conference with an 8-1 record and 1.82 ERA. Gingery has recorded the most strikeouts in a season by a Red Raider since Chad Bettis in 2010.

Baylor's Montana Parsons, the Co-Newcomer of the Year, had 13 starts and posted a 2.68 ERA with a 5-2 record. He ranks fourth in the Big 12 in ERA and innings pitched and tied for 11th in wins.

The Co-Newcomer of the Year, Oklahoma's Brylie Ware, earns OU's first major award winner since Sheldon Neuse (2014). He is the third OU Newcomer of the Year after hitting .317 and slugging .460 in his first season in Norman.

Texas Tech's Josh Jung led the team in runs with 53 to earn Freshman of the Year, which led the league. He hit .313 overall and .351 in conference while starting every game in his first year in Lubbock.

Steve Rodriguez earned the Big 12 Coach of the Year honor in his second season with Baylor. Rodriguez has guided Baylor to 34 wins for the first time since 2012, 12 conference wins for the first time since 2013 and its highest finish (fifth) in league play since 2013. He also led the Bears to a program-record-tying 15-2 start to the season and had the team ranked No. 10 in the country.

PHILLIPS 66 BIG 12 BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2017 Phillips 66 Big 12 Baseball Championship will be held at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark, May 24-28. The facility is home to the Los Angeles Dodgers Triple A team, the Oklahoma City Dodgers. Located in OKC's vibrant Bricktown District, the ballpark opened in 1998. Oklahoma City will host the event for the next three years, through the 2020 season.

This year marks the 18th time Oklahoma City has hosted the event. Three additional venues have sponsored the championship: All-Sports Stadium Oklahoma City (1997), The Ballpark in Arlington (2002, '04) and ONEOK Field in Tulsa (2015).
