NOTES

Four Big 12 programs are ranked in the national polls (USA Today/NFCA and ESPN/USA Softball), which is the second most among autonomy conferences: No. 2/2 Oklahoma, No. 11/13 Texas, No. 13/10 Texas Tech and No. 18/14 Oklahoma State.

Texas Tech broke into the top-10 for the first time in program history with a No. 10 ranking in the ESPN/USA Softball Top-25 Poll.

The Lady Raiders lead the Big 12 for the fifth consecutive week and rank second in the nation with a .960 winning percentage. The team also ranks third in the nation in batting average (.363) and fourth in on-base percentage (.448).

Oklahoma is in the top-5 national leaders in multiple categories including tied for 1st in home runs per game (1.68), 4th in slugging percentage (.619) and 5th in earned run average (1.28).

OU's 8-0 (5 inn.) win over then-ranked RV/No. 25 Northwestern extended their home winning streak to 41 straight games, good for the second-longest streak in program history. It also marked the Sooners' ninth run-rule and 10th shutout of the season.

Texas currently leads all of NCAA Division I in doubles with 50 this season in 25 games.

Shannon Saile (OU) earned Big 12 Pitcher of the Week honors after registering 20 strikeouts, the second-most in the league this week and a conference-best 14.48 strikeouts per seven innings. Karli Hamilton (TTU) was named Big 12 Player of the Week after leading the league with 30 total bases, tied for the league lead with five walks and 11 scored runs while hitting .550 at the plate.
