#### **Isaac Murphy, Texas Longhorns**

*On winning the decathlon...*

"It feels really good as I came out here and did what I came to do. I just wanted to be solid in my performances and gain points for the team. I struggled at the beginning of today but was able to be consistent and come away with the win."

**Men's Long Jump Champion****Marquise Goodwin, Texas Longhorns**

*On posting the winning jump right away...*

"I popped off my longest jump of the competition on the first jump. That was big for me because I had to run over and run the 100 meters in between jumps. I knew everybody was going to come out and do well, but that jump ended up winning it so it was all good."

**Men's Shot Put Champion****Jacob Thormaehlen, Texas Longhorns**

*On his thoughts entering shot put after a poor hammer throw...*

"I knew I had to do something because I was disappointed in my hammer performance. The shot is my specialty so I was confident. I just had to stay calm and having our throwing group rooting for each other helps us all out."

**Women's Pole Vault Champion****Natasha Masterson, Texas Longhorns**

*On winning and scoring points for the team...*

"I expected to do great today but I didn't think it would be like this. I wanted to jump really high today but winning is what makes me happy. All I have wanted to do is contribute to the team and help Texas do well. I feel like I did that today."

**Women's Pole Vault Champion****Natasha Masterson, Texas Longhorns**

*On her series of throws...*

"It was a pretty good series. [All of my throws] were for the most part over 18.00 meters, so I can't be too sad about that. It was a good meet overall."

*On winning a Big 12 title...*

"It means a lot to me. We have a really tough conference so to be able to win a conference championship is very exciting."
