BIG 12 CHAMPIONS FOR LIFE

Champions for Life is featuring two outstanding women. Coming from a single-parent home with four kids in the house, Jordan Moore of TCU knew in order for her to go to college, she needed a scholarship. BIG 12 NOTES

- Kansas won the Big 12 regular season title for the first time in history and earned its highest NCAA tournament seed (No. 5) in program history.
The Big 12 entered the NCAA tournament with the fewest non-conference losses in the nation (30) and as one of three leagues with a non-conference win percentage of .730 or higher.
The six NCAA bids this year match the third-highest in league history and most since 2011 (seven). It is also the highest total for the Conference since it began competition as a nine-team league in 2011.
The league's three national seed rankings in the NCAA Championship tied as second-most among all conferences.
The Big 12 is the only conference with at least 66 percent of its teams in the top 42 of the NCAA RPI poll.
Six of the league's nine teams own winning percentages of .500 or higher with five teams over .600.
Kansas' Kelsie Payne was selected as the All-Big 12 Player of the Year while teammates Cassie Wait earned Libero of the Year and Ainise Havili was named Setter of the Year. Ray Bechard received Coach of the Year honors for the second straight year.
Freshman of the Year Micaya White (Texas) tied for the most weekly honors ever received by a Big 12 individual (eight).
Baylor made its first NCAA appearance since 2011 after posting its most overall wins since 2009.
Texas earned the No. 4 overall ranking as part of the program's seventh consecutive appearance in the Championship as a top-four contender. The squad is coming off a NCAA Runner-Up finish a year ago.
No. 14 seeded K-State recorded its fifth appearance in six years.
