## NOTING THE AGGIES

- Texas A&M was second in the Big 12 and No. 10 in the NCAA in rushing offense, at 234.9 yards per game. The Aggies also ranked third in the conference in both total offense (442.3 ypg) and scoring offense (32.0 ppg).
- The Aggies were one of four schools in the country to average more than 200 yards rushing and receiving. (Texas A&M, Texas, USC and Toledo).
- Freshman punter Justin Brantly recorded 43.2 yards per kick, best among NCAA freshman punters. He also broke the school freshman record set by NFL All-Pro Shane Lechler.
- TAMU's average home attendance for 2005 was 79,732, third-best in school history.
