Big 12 Championship Notes

- TCU is currently 9-6 all-time in the Big 12 Championship.
- Kansas is currently 10-15 all-time in the Big 12 Championship.
- Kansas moves to 2-0 in all-time series against TCU during Big 12 Championship play.
- No. 2 seeds are currently 40-32 all-time in the Big 12 Championship
- No. 7 seeds are currently 23-34 all-time in the Big 12 Championship.
- The last time a No. 1 seed and a No. 2 seed lost in opening games of the Big 12 Championship was 2008.

TCU (39-15, 0-1 Big 12 Championship)

- Last time a Big 12 Championship No. 2 seed lost to a No. 7 seed was when No. 7 TCU beat No. 2 Oklahoma in 2013.
- TCU drops to 12-2 in games started by pitcher Nick Lodolo.
- Freshman Zach Humphreys hit his first career triple to knock in two RBIs in the bottom of the second.
- TCU's Austen Wade has reached base safely in 103 in 124 career games. Wade's RBI single in the bottom of the seventh marked his 17th multi-hit game of the 2017 season.
- TCU drops its first neutral site game of the year, moving to 3-1.

Kansas (30-26, 1-0 Big 12 Championship)

- The Jayhawks played the 14th toughest schedule in the NCAA, which ranks only second to Big 12 opponent No. 8 seed Oklahoma State who knocked off No. 1 seed Texas Tech earlier in the day.
- Kansas' starting pitcher Taylor Turski struck out eight and walked none through 6 and 1/3 innings, bringing his year total to 68 strikeouts in 76 innings pitched. Turski threw 108 pitches, 72 of them strikes.
- Kansas' Matt McLaughlin goes 2-for-3, including a two-RBI triple. McLaughlin has now reached base safely in 18 straight games.
- Devin Foyle hit a go-ahead RBI single in the top of the eighth. Kansas erupted to score four runs on four hits in the eighth.
